EXPLORE XI'AN

Xi'an, one of the oldest cities in China, is a treasure trove of history and culture. Known as Chang'an in ancient times, it served as the capital for 13 imperial dynasties, making it one of China's Four Great Ancient Capitals. Renowned for its abundant relics and sites and its cultural and historical significance, Xi'an has earned the title of a 'Natural History Museum'. The **Museum of Terracotta Warriors and Horses** is hailed as 'the Eighth Wonder of the World'. At the same time, the **Mausoleum of Emperor Qin Shi Huang** is listed on the **World Heritage List**, and the **City Wall of the Ming Dynasty** (1368 - 1644) stands as the **largest and best-preserved fortification** from the Ming Dynasty.
